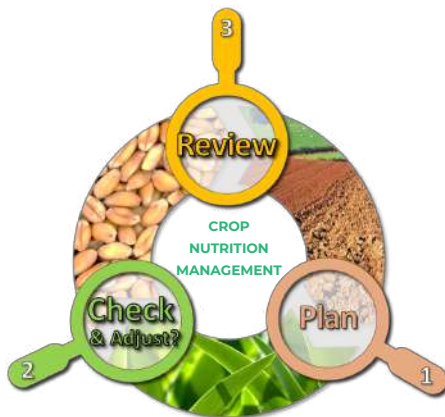

- Establish the NUTRI-CHECK NETWORK (NCN) to transform crop nutrition in Europe;

NUTRI-CHECK NET'S 3 STEP CHECKING APPROACH TO NUTRITION MANAGEMENT

- 1 - Planned** but few crops grow to plan. So then...
- 2 - Checked** during growth and **Adjusted** if necessary. Then...
- 3 - Reviewed** at final harvest to know the outcomes and to learn.
